## What do my fees cover?

Affiliation fee covers Wanneroo Districts Netball Association, Netball WA and Netball Australia, including hire of the courts, maintenance of the facilities, office staff, player insurance and competition costs.

NetSetGo (Year 2 to 5) registration includes a t-shirt and ball.

The Club Fee is set by Eels NC and covers equipment and storage, awards, umpire payments and general supplies.

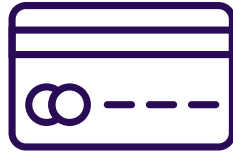
Fees are not inclusive of uniforms.

## How can I pay?



Card payment via our online registration system.

In 2025, participants registering with PlayHQ will have the option to make full payment, or alternatively to pay in fortnightly instalments using PayPal “Pay in 4”.

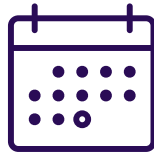

# Team Formation

## 'Coach First' Approach

In 2025, Ellenbrook Eels Netball Club will be taking a 'coach first' approach to our team formation. This means that we will first assign coaches to teams before opening player registrations into these teams. This will help us to ensure all of our coaches have time to prepare for the upcoming season, and that all of our teams have an enthusiastic and appropriately skilled coach.

## NetSetGo Teams

In 2025, Ellenbrook Eels Netball Club will be looking to provide consistency with NetSetGo (Year 2 to 5) teams from year to year. We see the benefits from both a player development and player relationship perspective in doing it this way.

Teams from 2024 will be prioritised where possible.

We will continue to grade our teams from 12&U and above.

# Grading

---



To ensure Eels players have equal opportunity for development, we will be grading for all age groups from 12&U and above.

Grading will still be held for age groups with one team to ensure they are nominated for the appropriate division. It will be held at Dayton District Open Space.

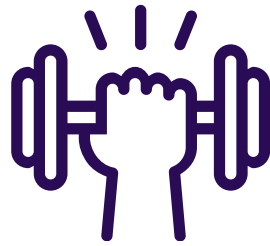
Grading will be held on **Tuesday 11 March**, time to be advised per age group.

Attendance at grading is mandatory, and is important for player placement in the appropriate team. All grading decisions are final, subject to agreement of the Grading Committee.



# Pre-season

---



Pre-season skills training will be held on **Tuesday 25 February** and **Tuesday 4 March** from 5:30-6:30pm, at Dayton District Open Space. The sessions will cover strength and conditioning, footwork and ball skills.

These sessions are for 12 & Under and above and are highly recommended to help prepare for grading and the upcoming season.

Please bring a water bottle and a towel each week.

Uniforms will be available for fittings.
