



SPECIAL RESOLUTION OF ELLENBROOK EELS NETBALL CLUB INC.

I, the undersigned, being a Member for the time being to receive notice of and to and vote at General Meetings of Ellenbrook Eels Netball Club. In accordance with the Constitution of the Association I hereby declare the Resolution to have been passed as a Special Resolution at an Annual General Meeting of Ellenbrook Eels Netball Club duly convened and held:

RESOLUTION

That membership shall consist of the following classes:

1. **Senior Members:** any person who registers as a senior player, is financial, is entitled to hold office, entitled to a vote and abides by the rules of netball;
2. **Junior Members:** any person who is under sixteen (16) years of age and registers as a junior player, is financial and abides by the rules of netball. Junior members are unable to hold office and must have a legal guardian to vote on their behalf;
3. **Non-Playing Members:** any person who is a financial member of the club, is entitled to hold office and enjoy full social benefits of the club, but does not wish to participate in the sporting activities of the club. Families of Junior Members are permitted up to one voting, non-playing member per family.
4. **Executive Members:** any person who the members consider to be of value to the running of the Club and is able to vote. Executive membership shall cease at the end of each financial year;
5. **Life Members:** any person who has given outstanding service to the Club for a length of time of ten (10) non-consecutive years, is not required to pay subscriptions, is entitled to vote;
 - a. Any member may nominate a person to the Committee for possible election, by that committee, as a life member;
 - b. The Committee will advise the member of the outcome of such nomination and the new Life Member, if successful, will be appointed at the next Annual General Meeting following such nomination;
 - c. One hundred and fifty (150) Senior games at the club by the same Senior Member will also constitute qualification for such nomination.
 - d. A maximum of two (2) Life Members can be appointed in a Calendar Year.

6. **Club Patrons:** a person who is a true reflection of the club, who will represent the club alongside the club president at events, is not required to pay subscriptions, is entitled to vote;
7. **Vice Club Patrons:** up to three (3) persons who is a true reflection of the club, who will represent the club alongside the club president at events, is not required to pay subscriptions, is entitled to vote;
8. **Sponsorship Members:** all sponsorship business or persons may elect two (2) representatives from their business to hold a sponsorship membership within the club, who is not required to pay subscriptions and is unable to vote. Sponsorship membership shall cease at the end of each financial year.
9. **Temporary Membership:** a person who is on any day visiting the club as a member or an official of, or assisting a team to contest a pre-arranged event against our club on that day; or at the invitation of a member to engage in that sport on that day, inclusive of a Single Game Voucher (SGV) or equivalent issued by the Association.
